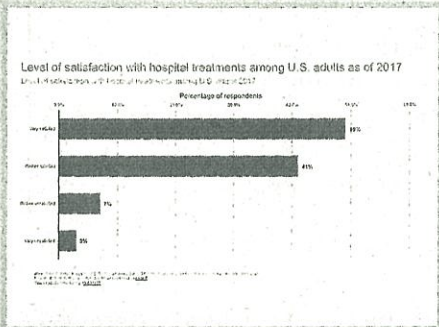
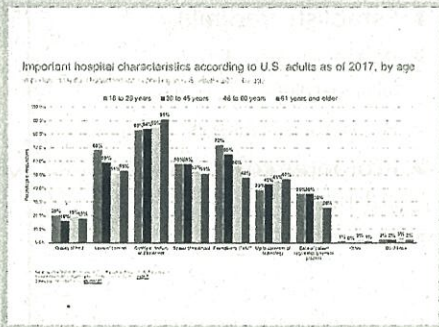

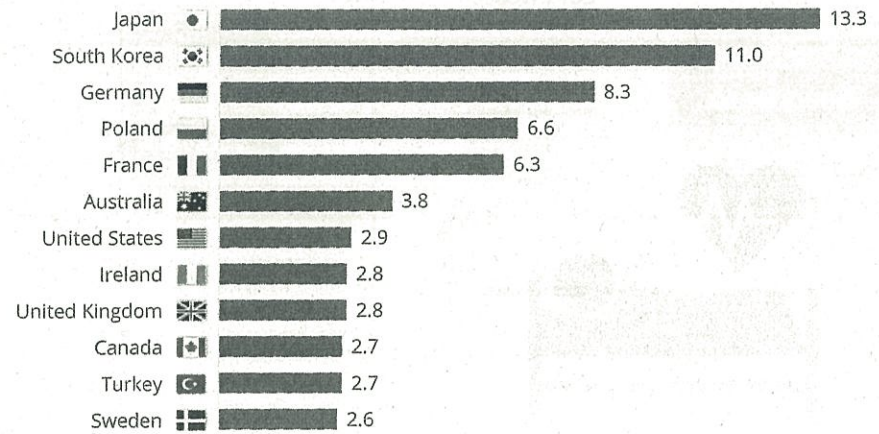

Total hospital beds per 1,000 of the population in selected countries*

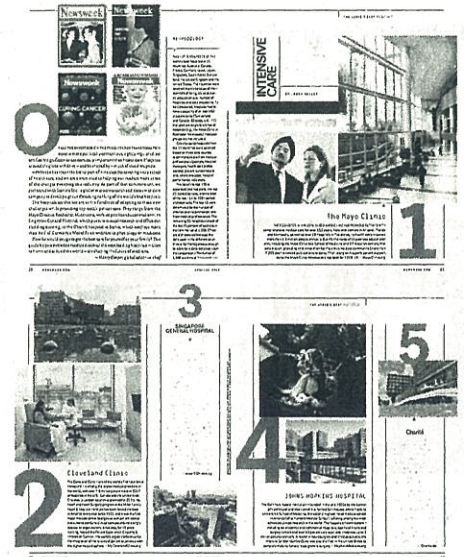
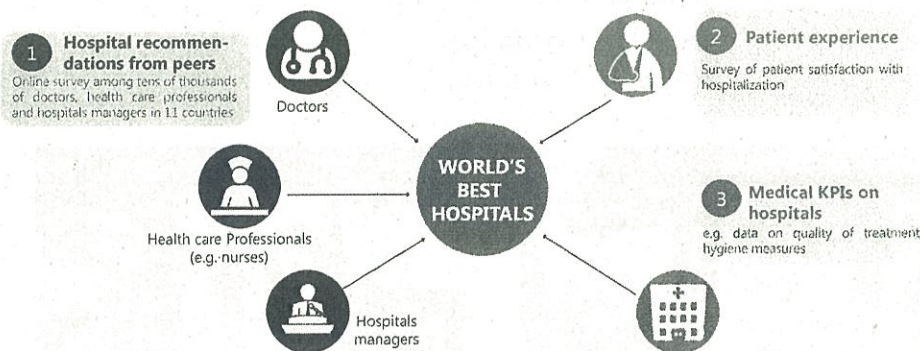
